<p>AVID is a program designed to prepare students in the academic middle for admissions to four-year universities.</p> <p>AVID students learn and develop skills to improve their academic success throughout their school careers.</p>	<p>AVID is an international program, adopted by over 3, 500 schools in 45 states as well as 15 countries.</p> <p>AVID has been taught at Hillsboro High School since 2006. HHS now offers the AVID elective class for grades 9th-12th.</p>	<p>Students learn study and organizational strategies, writing to learn skills, and critical thinking/questioning. With our weekly in-class study groups, students get academic help from AVID peers and college tutors. AVID participates in enrichment and motivational activities that make going to college seem realistic.</p>
