



- October 17th at Hillsboro
- Free and nothing you need to do ahead of Oct. 17th
- REQUIRED if you have not taken an official ACT
- Last chance to take ACT at Hillsboro


Taking the ACT at least once is a graduation requirement in the State of Tennessee. Students who do not take the ACT or SAT will not graduate.



GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- English: 4 credits
- Math: 4 credits (must be enrolled in a math class each year of high school)
- Science: 3 credits
- **Social Studies: 3.5 credits** (Personal Finance is a Social Studies credit)
- World Language: 2 credits (must be the same language)
- Fine Art: 1 credit
- Lifetime Wellness: 1 credit
- Physical Education: 0.5 credit
- Focus Elective Pathway: 3 credits
- Electives: 6 credits






What are some important college considerations?

- What else?







- Grades in college prep courses (AP, IB, Honors, Dual Enrollment)
- **Rigor** of Coursework, Strength of school curriculum
- Admissions **Test Scores** (ACT, SAT)
- Grades in All Courses
- Essays
- Demonstrated Interest
- Counselor Letter of Recommendation
 (ASK EARLY)
- **Teacher Letter of Recommendation** (ASK EARLY)
- Activities
- Special skills, talents, awards, community service & passions
- Interview

EARLY DECISION

Early Action

• Nonbinding

- Can apply to multiple schools EA (unless specified "single-choice")
- Receive response by January

<u>Early Decision</u>

- Binding you must attend if accepted
- Can only apply to one college ED
- Cannot apply to any schools EA, but can apply Regular Decision
- Not recommended if you want to compare financial aid offers
- EA and ED Deadline: November 1 (for most colleges)

FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID

- Application for Grants, Loans, Work-Study, Scholarships
- Required for Hope Scholarship, TN Promise, and other \$
- This year, the FAFSA is projected to open in December 2023 - the updated form will be shorter and will include updated terminology

TENNESSEE PROMISE

- FREE college tuition
- Deadline is November 1
- No GPA or ACT or income requirement

• Use at

- 2-year community colleges
- technical schools
- a few associate programs at 4-year schools
- Mandatory Meeting
- 8 hours of community service due in July

UT PROMISE

- Last-dollar scholarship at UT
- Knoxville, Chattanooga, Martin and Memphis
- Deadline is November 1
- Must qualify for HOPE Scholarship (next slide)
- Household income under \$50,000 a year

Hope Scholarship

• 3.0 <u>unweighted</u> GPA <u>OR</u> 21 ACT

• 4-year college:

- Up to <u>\$2,250</u> per full-time enrollment semester as a freshmen and sophomore
- Then up to <u>\$2,850</u> per full-time enrollment semester as a junior and senior

• 2-year college:

- Up to <u>\$1,600</u> per full-time enrollment semester as a freshman and sophomore
- Must complete the FAFSA

- Must make an account with the NCAA Eligibility Center at <u>www.eligibilitycenter.org</u>
- Must have 2.3 NCAA core GPA

- October 17: ACT for seniors at Hillsboro
- November 1: Deadline to sign up for TN Promise
- December: Start your FAFSA
 - for the 2024 2025 school year!
- March 1: FAFSA due for TN Promise aim for sooner though!



TIPS TO MAKE THE COLLEGE PROCESS EASY-ISH

- START EARLY
- BE ORGANIZED
 - Get a college folder or binder and organize bookmarks online
 - Write down passwords you'll have
 - 2,986,342 user ID/passwords
- BE EARLY FOR DEADLINES
- CHECK YOUR (student's) EMAIL DAILY
- START APPLYING FOR
